A little history

- The issue: minimum bar entry age = 19 (after 10:00)
- 2010: Council passes 21 ordinance with UI support (inc. expanded conduct enforcement, funding for late night entertainment)
- 2011: Referendum to repeal 21 ordinance- defeated 52% to 48%
- 2013: Referendum to repeal 21 ordinance- defeated 66% to 34%.

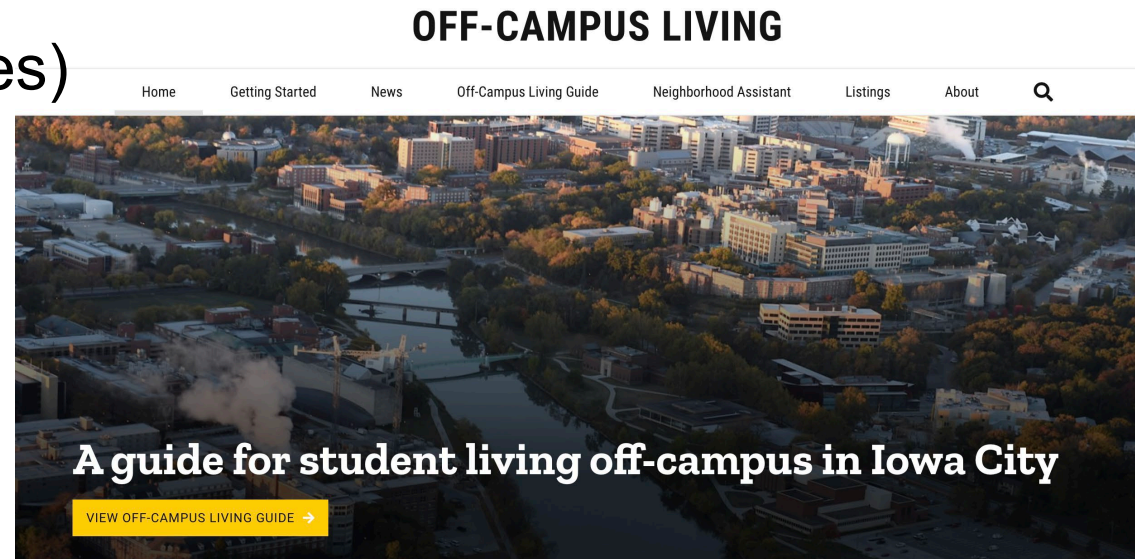
21-Ordinance Fears and Reality

- Tumbleweeds blowing through streets of downtown Iowa City
 - UI fell and finally fell off the Party School rankings
 - Improved mix of downtown businesses (several of most problematic bars closed)
 - More people returned to use downtown for dining, entertainment, business
- Mayhem in the neighborhoods
 - Enrollment not affected
- Decreased enrollment

Additional Collaborations
