
Join us April 12 for an exclusive sneak peek of the new University of Iowa Health Care – North Liberty campus, opening April 28!



There is a significant increase in the number of students using Campus Test Centers during finals week due to make-up exams and accommodated testing. We've reserved **2520D UCC** for additional testing space and we're looking for staff volunteers to help administer exams to students that week **(May 12 – 16, 2025)**. Please note that volunteers must complete FERPA training (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act), which can be done online: https://registrar.uiowa.edu/faculty-and-staff-ferpa-training.

Please <u>complete this sign-up sheet</u> if you or others in your area can volunteer a bit of time during finals week. Proctoring duties and responsibilities may include:

- o **Preparing Exams and Rooms** set up exam materials and testing spaces to create an organized and secure environment.
- Student Check-In/Check-Out familiarize students with exam guidelines, ensuring they understand what materials are allowed during testing. Seat students upon check-in and record seat numbers. Assist with check-out and collect completed exams.
- o **Exam Proctoring** observe students completing exams to ensure compliance with restrictions and allotted time; report any concerns to administrators.
- o **Scanning/Uploading/Filing Exams** Scan, upload, and file completed paper exams.
